
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Year 2 Homework Challenge – Summer Term 2 2024

We would like children to select at least one of the homework challenges below for this term, however children can do as many as they wish. This will continue to be run alongside the regular weekly homework.

<p><u>Science – Solar System</u></p> <p>Create our solar system, think about the planets you would include and the order they go in. You could make a 3D model or draw it for example.</p> 	<p><u>DT – Moving Vehicles</u></p> <p>Use Lego, Mechano or any other construction material to build a moving vehicle with wheels. Explain how you created your vehicle.</p> 	<p><u>History</u></p> <p>Be a journalist and write an article all about a famous person in history. Include facts about their lives, achievements and how it has shaped our future.</p> 
<p><u>PSHE</u></p> <p>Create a developmental timeline of yourself from when you were a baby to now. You could include pictures and write about how you have changed!</p> 	<p><u>R.E – Islam - Hajj</u></p> <p>Write or draw about a special journey you have been on. What made it special?</p> 	<p><u>Music</u></p> <p>Use body percussion to create a beat for a piece of music. Either draw or record yourself performing it.</p> <p>Body Percussion</p>  <p>Clap Snap Pat Stomp</p>
