English

In English this half term, Year 5 will be learning to write a Historical Narrative. Year 5 will develop an understanding of the key features needed in writing a historical narrative through Talk 4 Writing methods. They will then innovate on the model text before 'inventing' and writing their own. The class text we will be reading this half term is 'Street Child' by Berlie Doherty. Year 5 will then be moving onto some creative writing, applying the knowledge they have learnt across the year.

Year 5 will be consolidating aspects of previously learnt grammar, punctuation and spelling.



Maths

In Maths this half term, Year 5 will be exploring further work on decimals, looking at efficient strategies, adding and subtracting decimals and multiplying and dividing decimals by 10, 100 and 1000. We will then move onto converting units such as kilograms, millimetres and metric and imperial measurements. Finally, we will explore comparing and estimating volume and capacity as well as completing word problems.

There are additional challenge activities on hand each lesson to promote reasoning, problem solving and fluency skills. Maths will be taught through the mastery approach with White Rose Maths. In Year 5 your child will have daily mental arithmetic sessions, gap fill sessions as well as opportunities to practise their times tables.
